Silent Signals - a behaviour approach at St Peter's

To strengthen behaviour, routines, and learning across the school, we are introducing a new shared approach to silent signals. These signals create calm, focused environments, support smooth transitions, and maximise learning time.

When every adult uses the same signals consistently, pupils feel confident and clear about expectations. These silent signals will be used by all staff (teachers, teaching assistants, admin staff, and midday supervisors) in all areas of the school, including classrooms, playgrounds, corridors, the dinner hall, and assemblies.

We have talked to all the children about this new approach, the reasons why and how this will help bring a calm and consistent approach to behaviour management across the school. There will be no confusion as children meet different staff throughout the day, as we will all be doing the same thing.

Big Talk RSE - 21st May

On 21st May, our school will be working with Big Talk Education to deliver Relationship and Sex Education (RSE) sessions across the school. Big Talk are specialists in providing age-appropriate, safeguarding-focused RSE that helps children understand their bodies, learn how to stay safe, and develop the language and confidence to speak up if something worries them.

At primary level, the focus is firmly on safety, respect, healthy friendships, and understanding private body parts in a way that is appropriate for each age group. This forms an important part of our safeguarding curriculum and supports children's wellbeing as they grow.

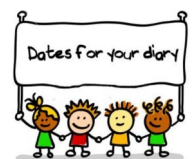
