Behaviour Curriculum - Summer Term

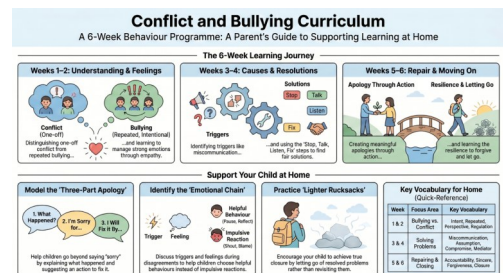
As part of our Behaviour Curriculum, we will be delivering a series of lessons focusing on Conflict and Bullying.

Through these sessions, children will develop their understanding of the difference between conflict and bullying, learn how to manage disagreements in a positive and respectful way, and build the skills needed to resolve situations and move forward. The curriculum aims to give pupils the confidence, language and strategies to respond appropriately when challenges arise.

The curriculum will be taught in weekly class sessions and reinforced through daily interactions across the school.

A leaflet is being sent home which provides further information about the content being covered, along with guidance on how you can support your child at home. We encourage you to read this and discuss the key messages together.

Working in partnership with families is key to helping children develop these important life skills.
