Dear Parents and carers,

As Mrs Houghton-Hill is not in school I am writing to you on behalf of the school and the Trust.

The Ofsted report from the April inspection is now available. A copy can be found on the school website [St Peter's C of E Primary Academy - Ofsted](#) Both St Peter's and LAAT, the Trust to which the school belongs, are deeply disappointed by the outcome of the inspection. While the findings are difficult to receive, we fully accept the areas for improvement identified and are committed to acting swiftly and decisively in response.

We want to reassure parents, carers, and the wider community that immediate and targeted steps are already underway to address all areas highlighted in the report. This work is being led by the Trust's experienced and capable leadership team, and includes the following key measures:

- Bringing in Miss Wilson to support leadership in the school and drive forward change
- Putting in place an Interim Executive Board, to support Governors, and
- Bringing in a team of Education Development Advisor and a Trust Educational Welfare Officer
- Implementing a Rapid Action Plan with clear priorities, objectives, and timeframes.

Significant progress has already been made, including:

- Regular safeguarding training is now embedded
- The number of trained first aiders on site has been increased
- A new, robust First Aid recording and reporting system is in place
- Updated attendance protocols have been introduced, and an Attendance Champion appointed
- A full external Health and Safety audit has been completed
- Targeted values-based support from local sports organisations (such as Grimsby Town) has been secured, focusing on respect, behaviour, and addressing negative attitudes


