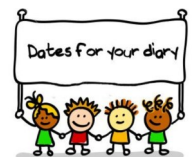

KS2 Play ground Works!

Next week there will be some changes to how KS2 pupils will enter and exit the building due to some exciting work happening on our KS2 playground.

The work will take place on **Monday 10th November and Tuesday 11th November.**

Mornings/drop-off:

We ask that KS2 pupils enter through the KS1 gate (Cuttleby) and proceed to the hall doors, where the Children will be directed down to their classrooms.

Afternoon/pick-up:

The children will also be dismissed from the hall doors that lead onto the KS1 playground. Parents should enter the KS1 playground through the Cuttleby entrance and wait for children in the KS1 playground next to the hall.

Breakfast club:

Entrance as normal.

We also ask KS2 pupils to **not** come on scooters/bikes as storage is limited in the KS1 playground (though parents are welcome to take these home after drop-off).

The works should only take two days and normal service should be resumed on **Wednesday 12th November.**
